Ron K. Miller is a musician, synesthete, and author based in Rogers, Arkansas. He has played piano, guitar, drums, cello, and ukulele for over thirty years, and he writes at the intersection of music, neuroscience, and the physics of sound. He is a synesthete: he sees music as color and shape, and spent most of his life assuming this was universal. It isn't.

RESONANCE is his first book: a nonfiction argument that music is not entertainment but biological infrastructure, a property of reality humans learned to interface with rather than invented.

Ron K. Miller is a musician with over thirty years of experience performing and composing across multiple instruments. Piano is his primary instrument, the one where he hears and feels most clearly. He also plays guitar, drums, cello, and ukulele, and has spent his adult life inside music in ways that go well beyond entertainment.

He is a synesthete. When he hears music, he sees it: color, shape, and spatial position arrive involuntarily alongside the sound. He spent most of his life assuming everyone experienced this. Learning otherwise was the seed that became *RESONANCE*.

RESONANCE is a nonfiction exploration of what music actually is, what it does to the human body and brain, and what it might mean that the universe appears to be built on the same mathematical structures that make music work. The book spans neuroscience, physics, evolutionary biology, and personal narrative, arguing that music is not a cultural invention but a property of physical reality.

Miller writes with warmth, humor, and a commitment to scientific rigor. He is not a scientist by training, but a musician who followed a question all the way down. The result is a book that treats its readers as intelligent adults, avoids jargon without avoiding complexity, and builds its argument through a combination of research, lived experience, and honest inquiry.

He lives in Northwest Arkansas with his wife and three children, one of whom has Down syndrome. *RESONANCE* is his first book.
